

ROD BUILDING TOOLS

Mark Crouse was born in Union Town, Pennsylvania in the early 1960's. Before he was six years old, his family had lived in Missouri, New Mexico, California and North Carolina. In 1969, Mark moved with his mother to Munich, Germany. He started building fishing rods at the age of 12. What started as an accident has become a life-long profession for Mark. While living in Europe, he specialized in Long Rods that were used for Steelhead and Carp, as well as portable gaffs. He continued building rods in Europe until he returned to the United States in 1993.

Since thread art was a new application for rod building, Mark had to develop his own techniques and materials. Mark's work is known throughout the world. He was the only Western World participant in the 2001 Japanese Thread Art Festa. His work has even been documented by various authors and publications.

While developing his own techniques and methods for thread art, Mark developed tools specific to this application. Mark has finally decided to make these tools available to other crafters interested in improving their finished products.

The Split Grip Cork Clamp comes in two sizes:

36-inch for all longer rods. i.e. Surf, English Carp, Steelhead, etc.

24-inch for shorter rods.

Don't forget to slide on your Winding Checks before gluing the Handle!



LARGE HAND WRAPPER BENCH

The Large Hand Wrapper Bench is perfect for building any type of rod you desire. Your tools can be kept out of your immediate work area and still be within easy reach.

The spool holders can accommodate all brands of thread, including Gudebrod, Talbot, Holland, Fishhawk, and Madeira. The bench provides space for up to 12 working spools of thread. This should provide enough variety for even the most complicated designs.

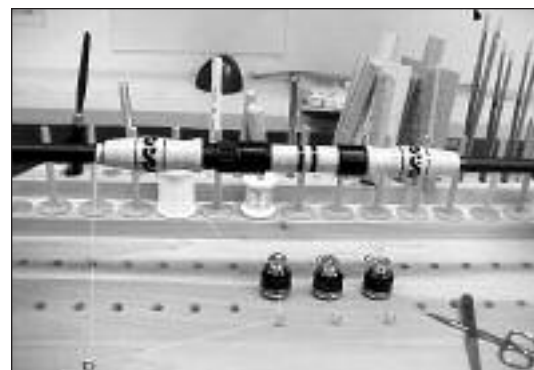
The unit also includes two bench-mounted supports and two free-standing supports.



LARGE HAND WRAPPER BENCH

The Hand Wrapper also includes several of the tools that I find most useful: an Exacto knife for cutting thread ends flush; a White China Marker for marking centers and guide spacing; a Large Needle Pick for flattening weaves; a Small Needle Pick for lifting threads, especially useful for crossed designs; a Burnishing Tool for eliminating spaces in the wraps; a pair of scissors for general use; a pair of tweezers for pulling the thread ends to assist with a "flush" cut; a Spatula for mixing and spreading glue; a Thread Gauge for measuring trim bands; brushes for applying finish coat and color preserver; and wood sticks for mixing epoxy.

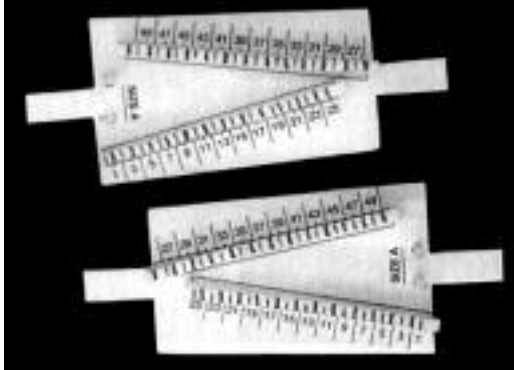
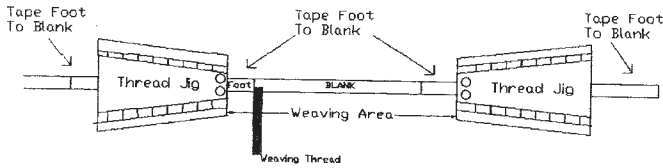
Weaving jigs are not included; however every bench includes a bore for them.

WONDER WEAVER TWO WHEEL VERSION

This version of the Wonder Weaver is designed to be used where it is not convenient to use the left side tube of the regular three wheel model. The large bore wheel has been coupled with the regular right side wheel to give a combination that will accommodate most pistol grip and trigger type reel seats as well as Fly Rods where there is no blank to the left of the reel seat. It can be used in place of the regular three wheel model but thread control on the left side is dependent upon location. We recommend mounting the left side as far left as practical when using Metallic threads to prevent long tails from tangling with one another.

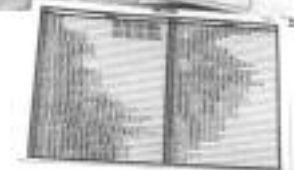

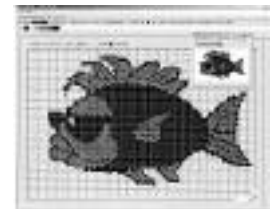

- Import image files from photos, scans etc (bmp, jpg, etc) or start with a blank grid.
- Automatically create a grid pattern from an imported image.
- Choice of 'Simple' or 'Advanced' sizing modes. Simple sizing allows you to specify the number of rows & columns. Advanced sizing takes into account the size of the rod, thread sizes and desired finished pattern size to suggest a resulting grid size.
- Auto color-matching. The software chooses the closest available thread

colours to match the colors in the original image.

- Palette-limiting. This allows you to select which thread colors the software can use in the grid pattern.
- Preloaded with typical thread colours from known manufacturers.
- Grid editing tools for easy manipulation of the grid image (freehand paint, outline, block fill, erase, swap, undo).
- Ability to underlay the original image beneath the grid for comparison or pattern tracing.

VISUAL WRAP

VisualWRAP is a unique software package for fishing rod builders. It lets you design decorative cross wraps for custom fishing rods, view them in 3D, and calculate layout spacings for your blank.

VisualWRAP is a software tool for working with decorative cross wraps. It lets you design, edit, view and share cross wrap thread patterns.

Cross wrap patterns are built up by laying colored threads onto a rod in a certain sequence. Patterns in VisualWRAP are based on a similar principle - using a scripting language you tell the software where to place threads and in what order. The software then draws threads on the screen, showing how the pattern will develop.

The pattern is drawn in 2D and can then be sent to a 3D viewer. This lets you see the pattern from any angle in space.

You can print out the 2D pattern scaled to the size of your blank. This is useful for laying out patterns, but also for showing how the pattern is going to look on your rod. You can print out a table showing the layout spacings to suit a tapered rod, or take measurements from the printed image.

A special recipe page draws the pattern at critical stages of its development, so you can see how it should be looking. You print the recipe and use it as a guide while you do the wrap.
